Women and Girls Umpire incentive




- Financial incentive and reward to Clubs who drive Women and Girls Umpire recruitment
- Clubs that achieve a 1:1 ratio of female Umpires to Youth Girls Teams will receive a cashback grant at the end of the year
- Umpires must officiate a minimum of two (2) matches across the season
- Cashback grant of \$500

Under 10 & Under 12 gala days



- Ideal scenario is clubs each field a team (4 teams may opt for home & away)
 - Under 12 competition could start straight away
 - Under 10 remains non-competitive
- Least ideal scenario is no clubs have a team and players are allocated on the day
- Hybrid model is some clubs with teams, other clubs sending players to be allocated



Age Dispensation Policy



- Application to play down an age group can be made on basis of physical size:
 - Where player is in bottom 5th percentile by BMI for age; OR
 Where player is in bottom 5th percentile by height for age
- Second factor is new in 2023





- Scope to receive a suspended sentence has been removed
- Means that outcome is either not guilty (no sanction), or guilty and weeks off
- Change in 2023
