Age Dispensation Application to Play Down

This Application form is established in accordance with Clause 4.1(b)(i) of the *National Community Football Policy Handbook* and Rule 11.2.3 of the *AFL NSW/ACT Rules*. The Application is to be used by a Club seeking approval from the Controlling Body for a Player to play in a lower Grade for which the Player is no longer age eligible. The Application can only be based on the grounds of *Disability* or *Physical Size Considerations* as defined in Clause 1.1 of the *National Community Football Policy Handbook*.
